

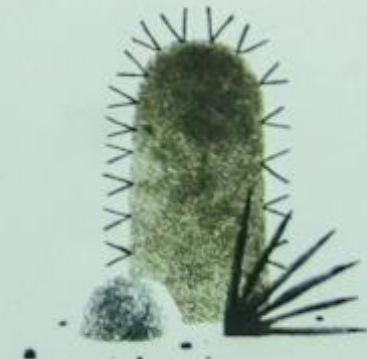
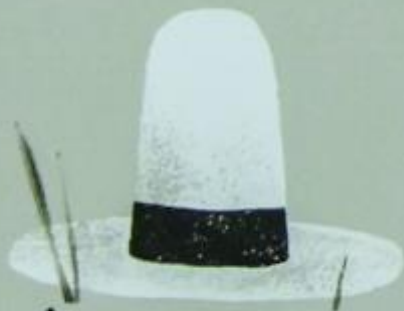

# Finding the Hat



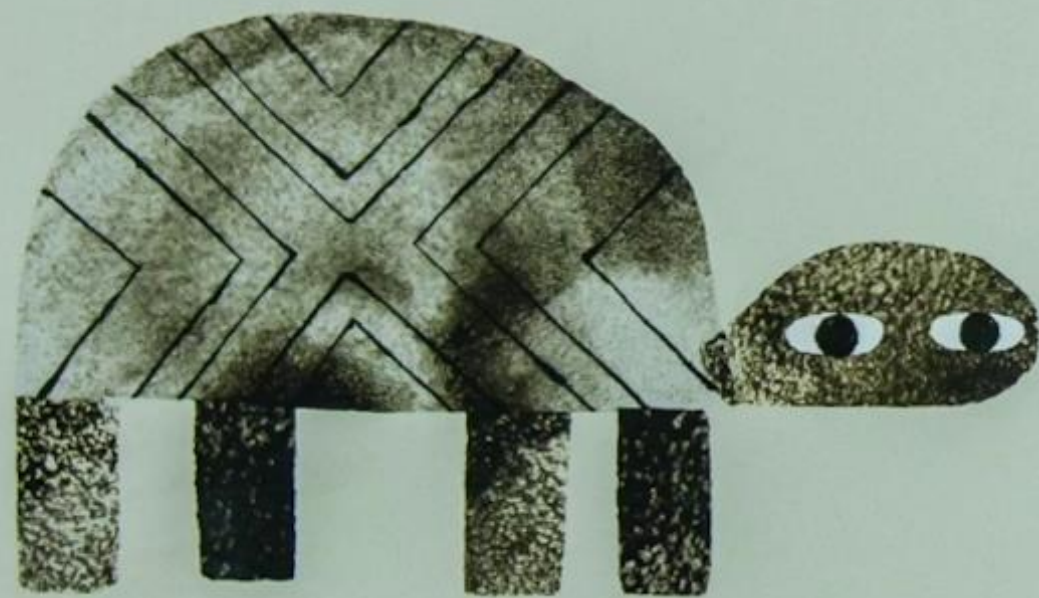
We found a hat.

We found it together.

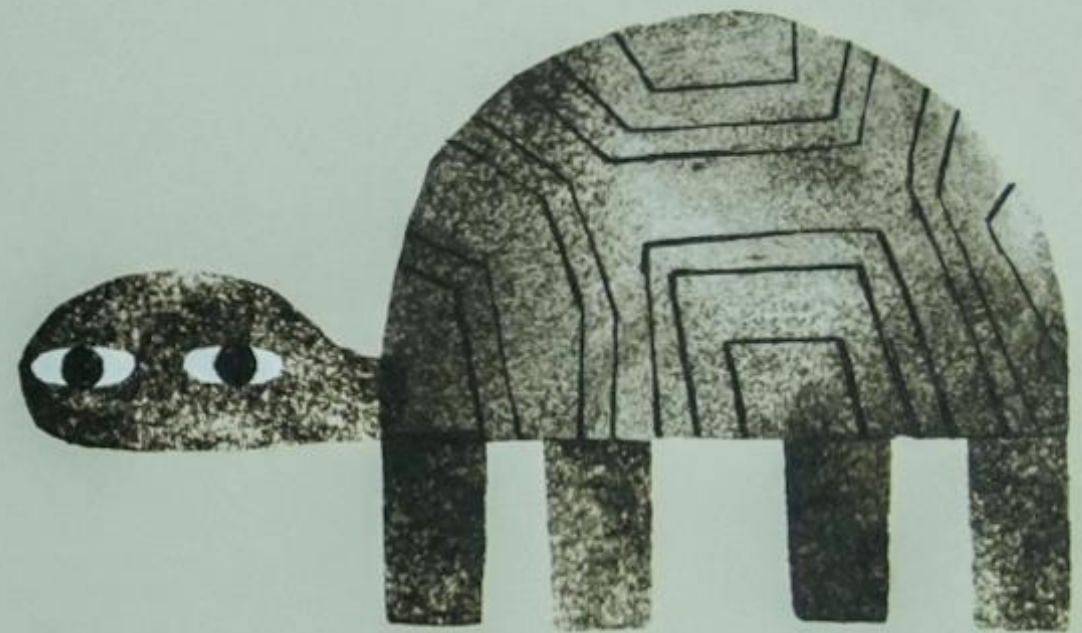




But there is only one hat.

and forget that we found it.

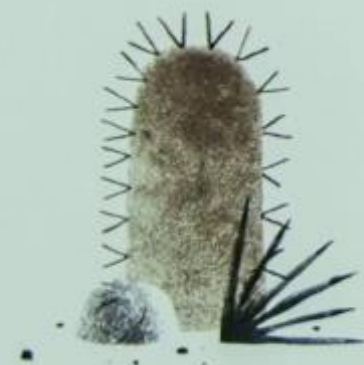

We are watching it together.





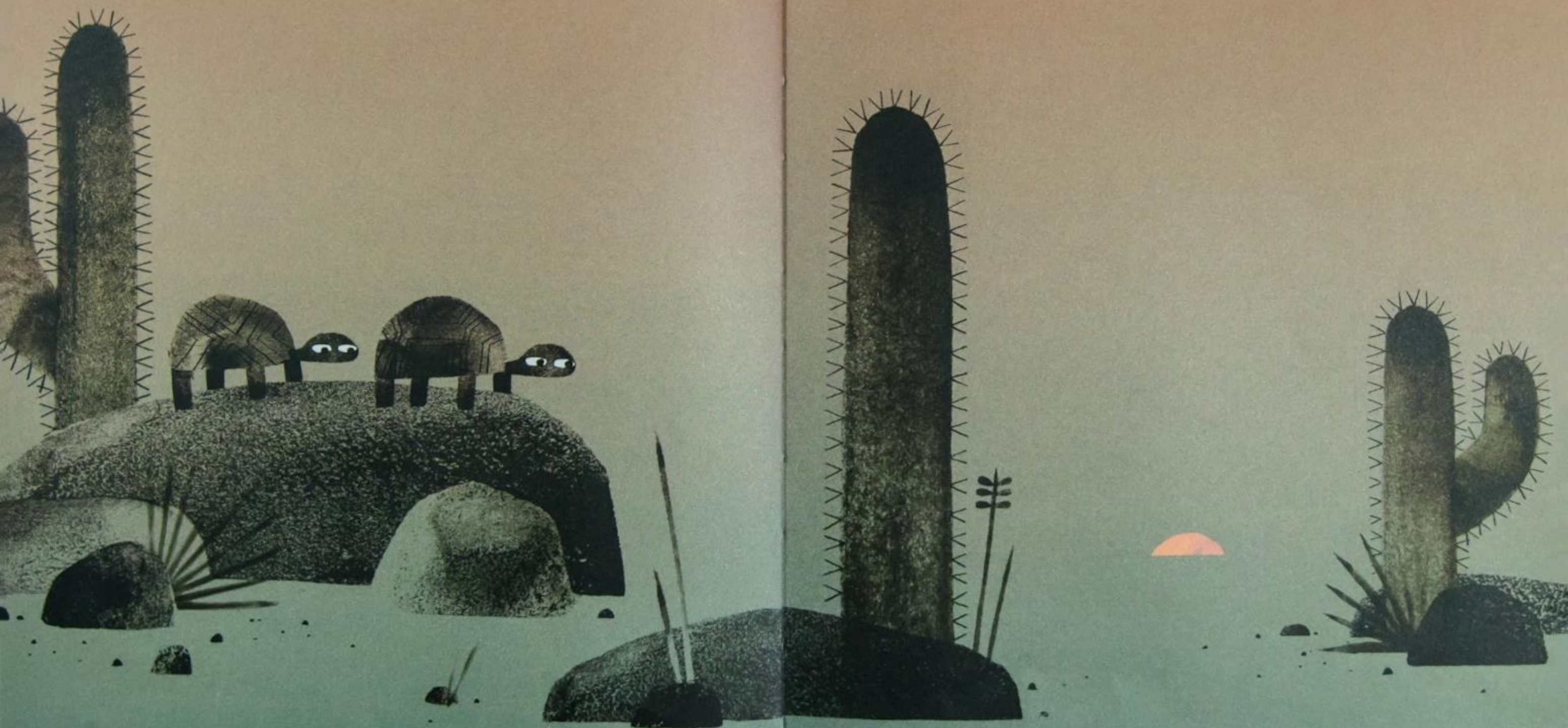
What are you thinking about?

I am thinking about the sunset.



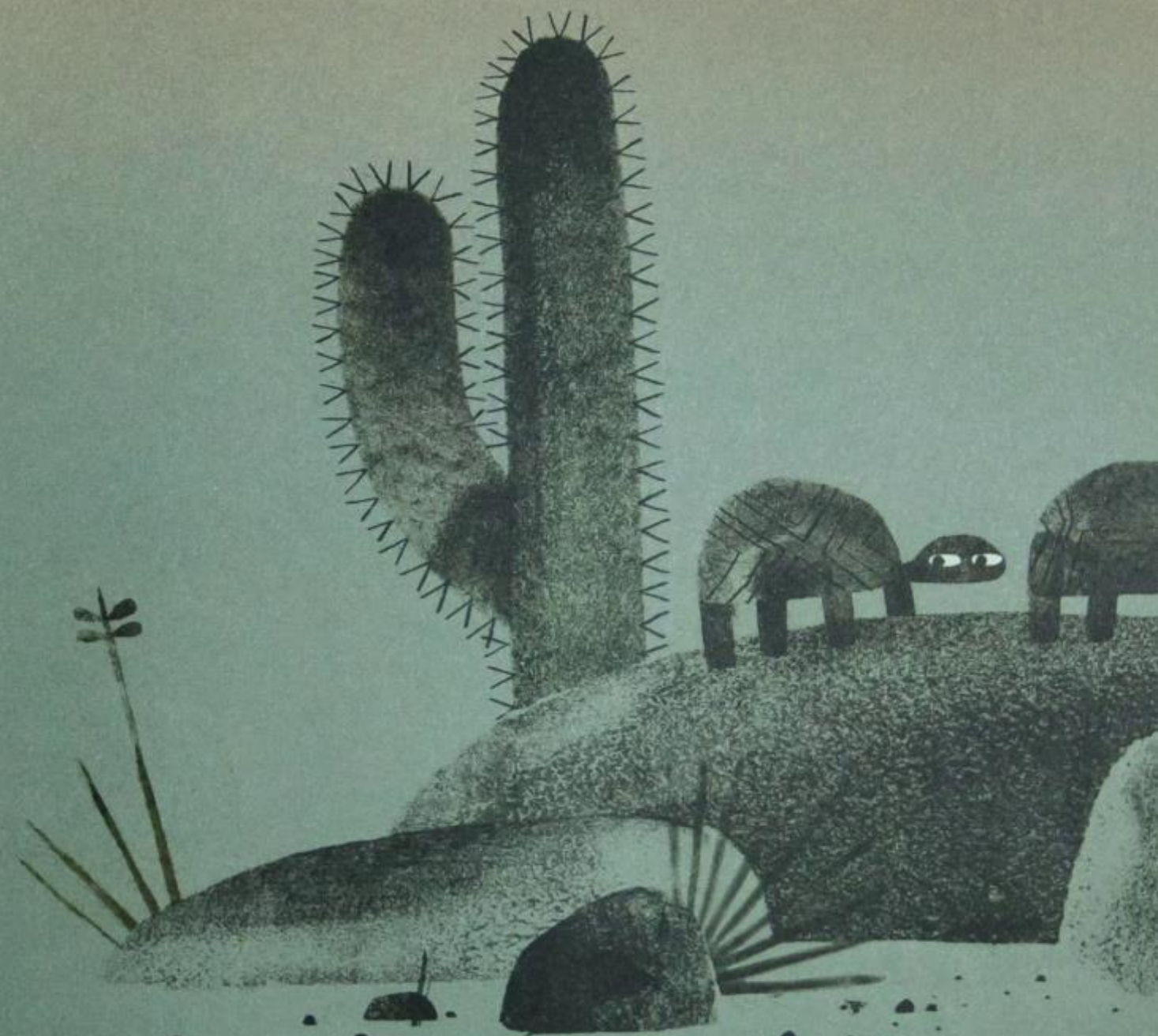


What are you thinking about?

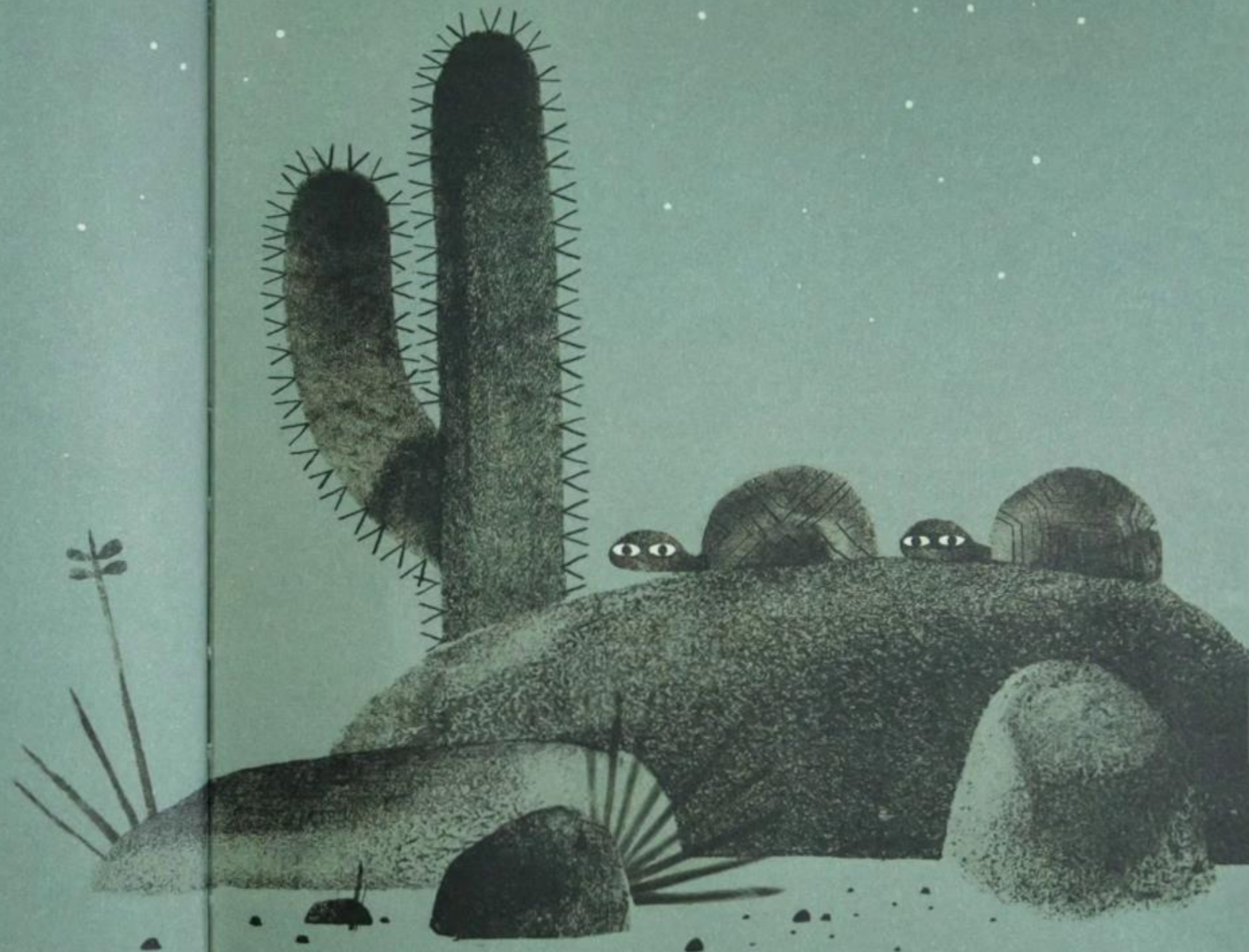
Going

We are going to sleep.

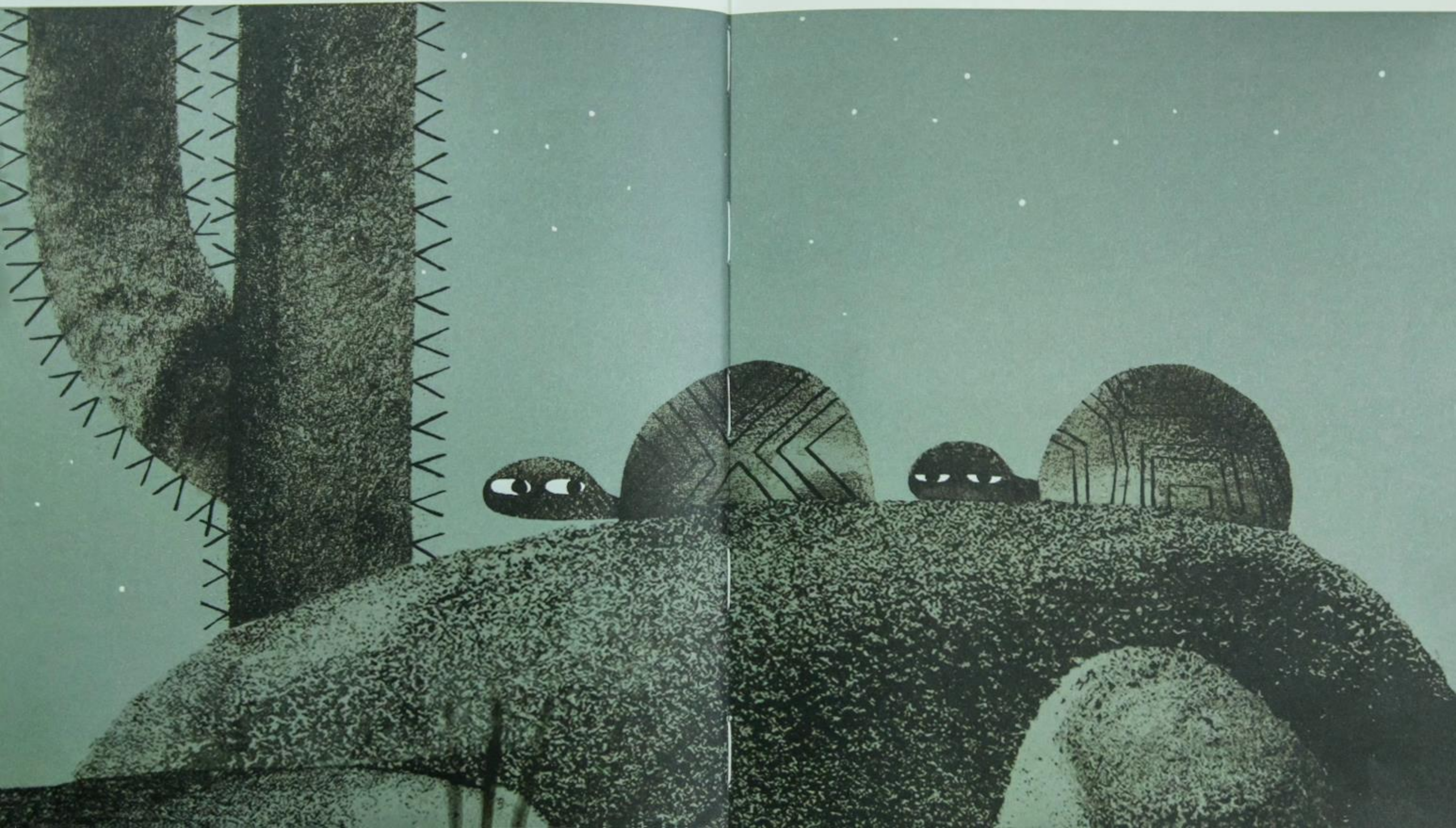
We are going to sleep here together.

I am dreaming a dream.

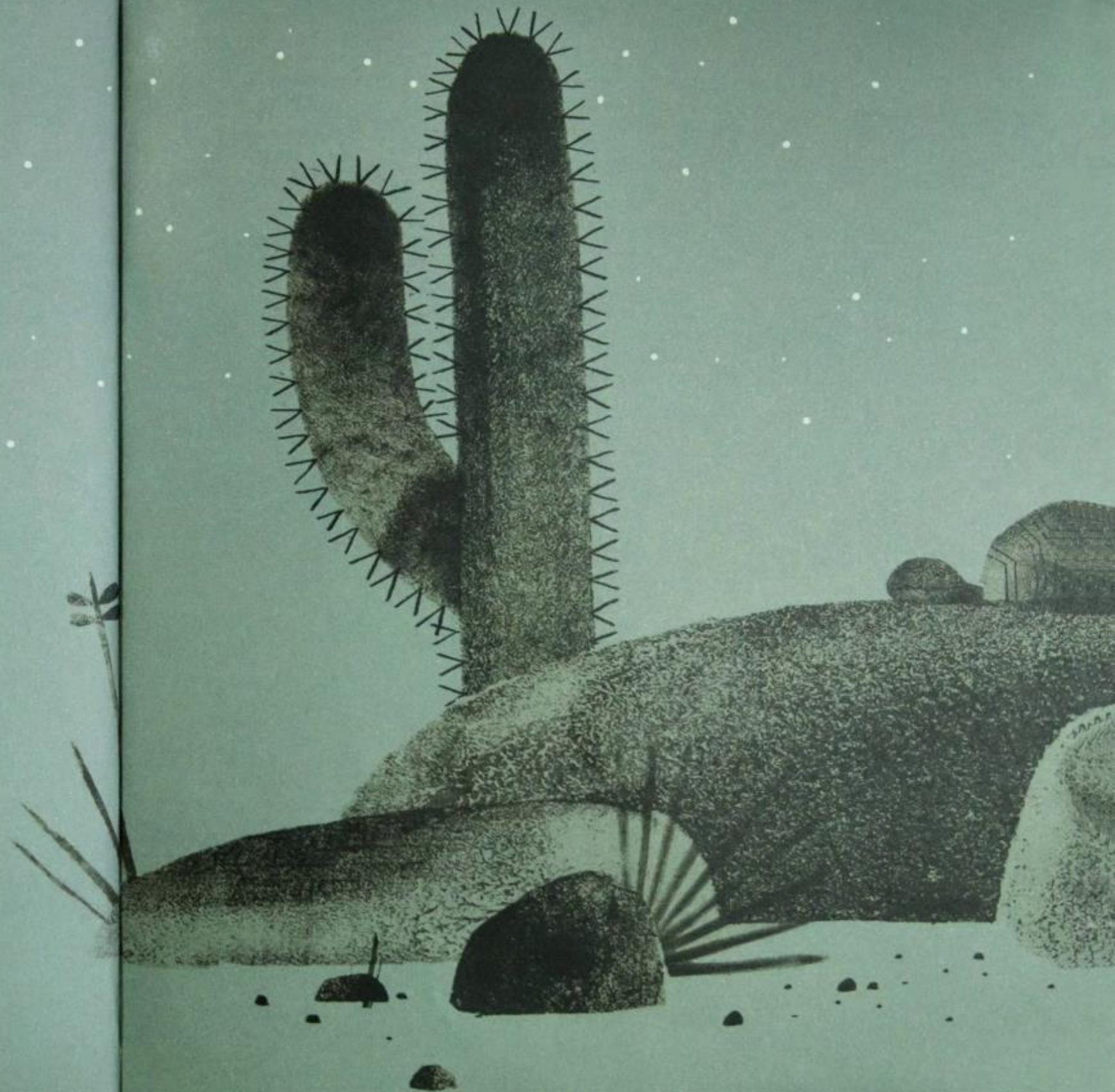




What are you dreaming about?
