






Little Elliot was an elephant.

in many ways.




Little Elliot loved living in a big city,

small in such a huge place.






He had to be careful not
to be stepped on.





He had trouble opening doors.




And he could never catch a cab.




Even life at home was a bit challenging.

. . . small treasures . . .




. . . and most of all, cupcakes!

who had an even bigger problem.


“I’m trying to reach some food

"I can help!" said Elliot.






Elliot felt like the tallest elephant in the world!
