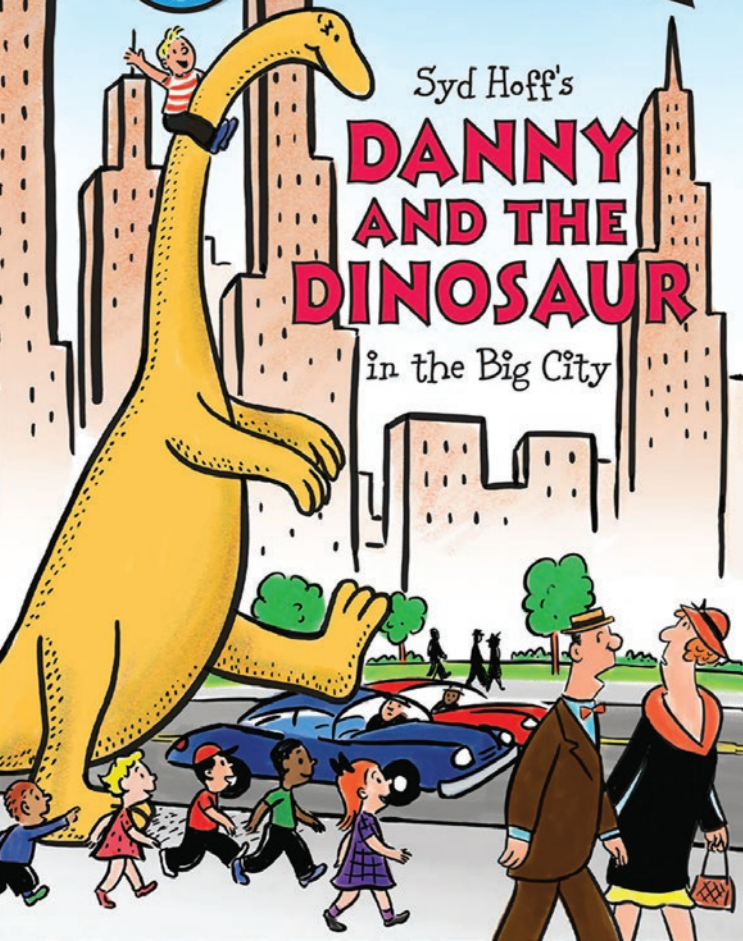

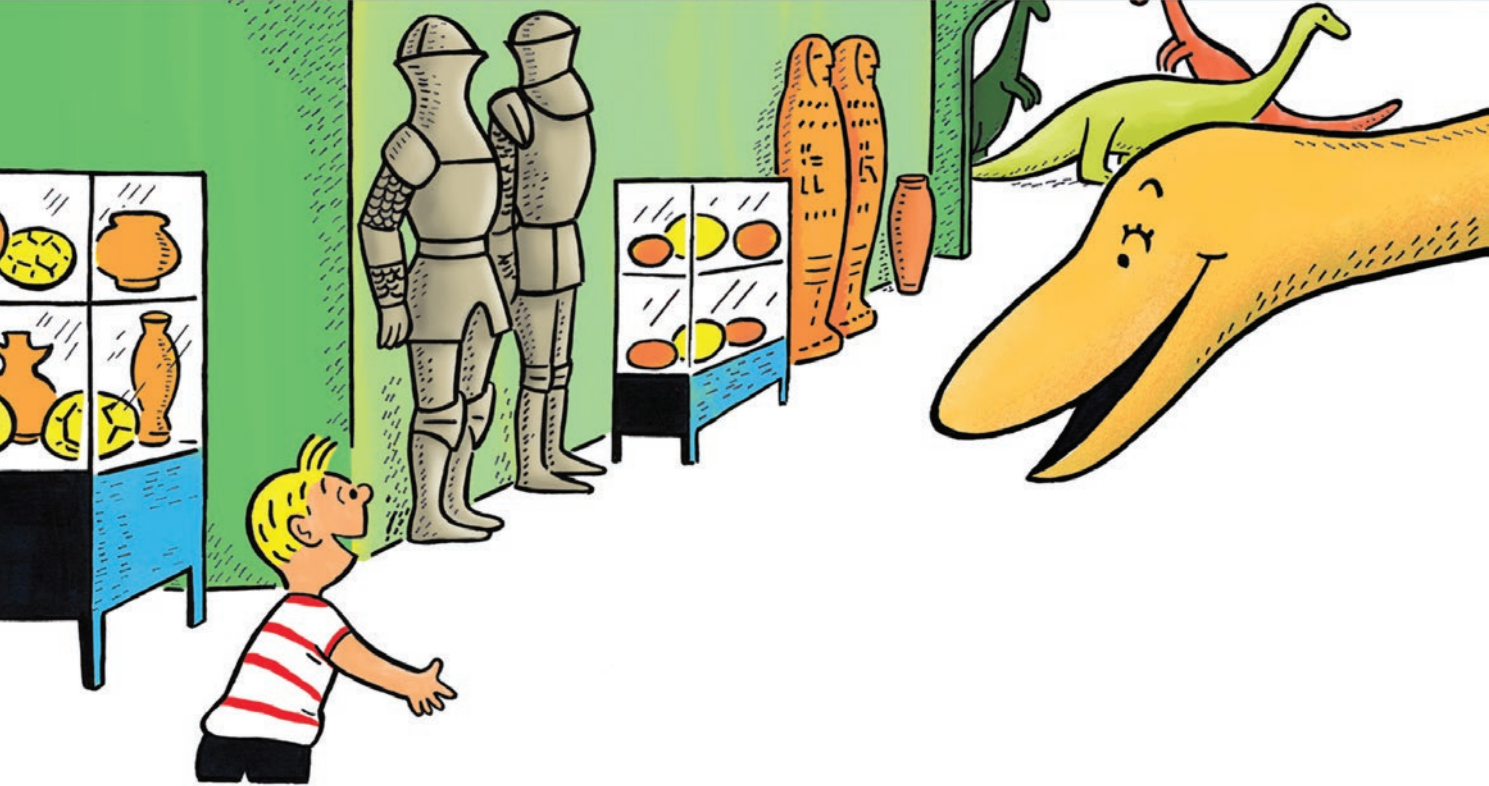

“Where?” asked the dinosaur.

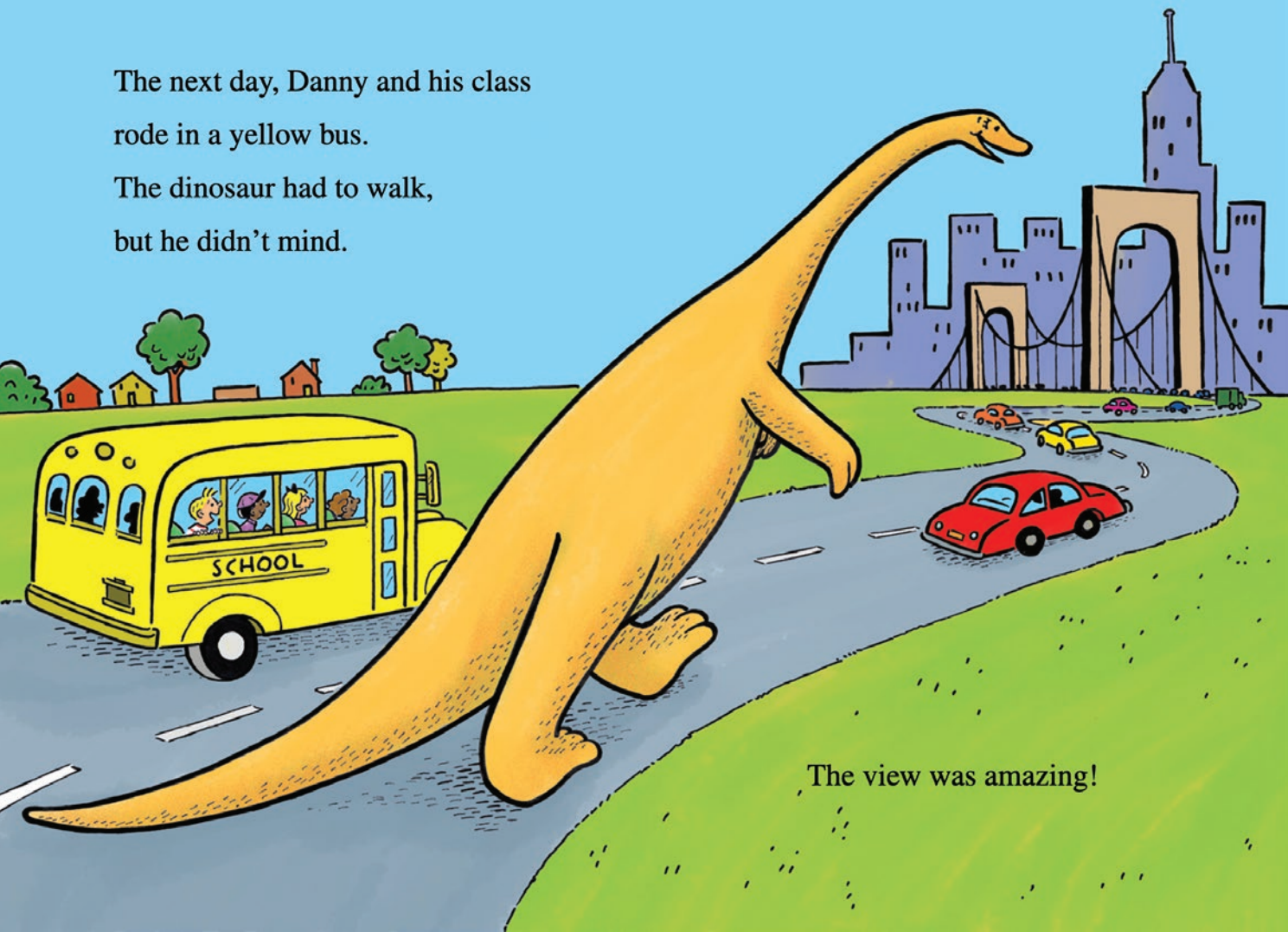
“My class is taking a field trip

“And you’re invited too!”

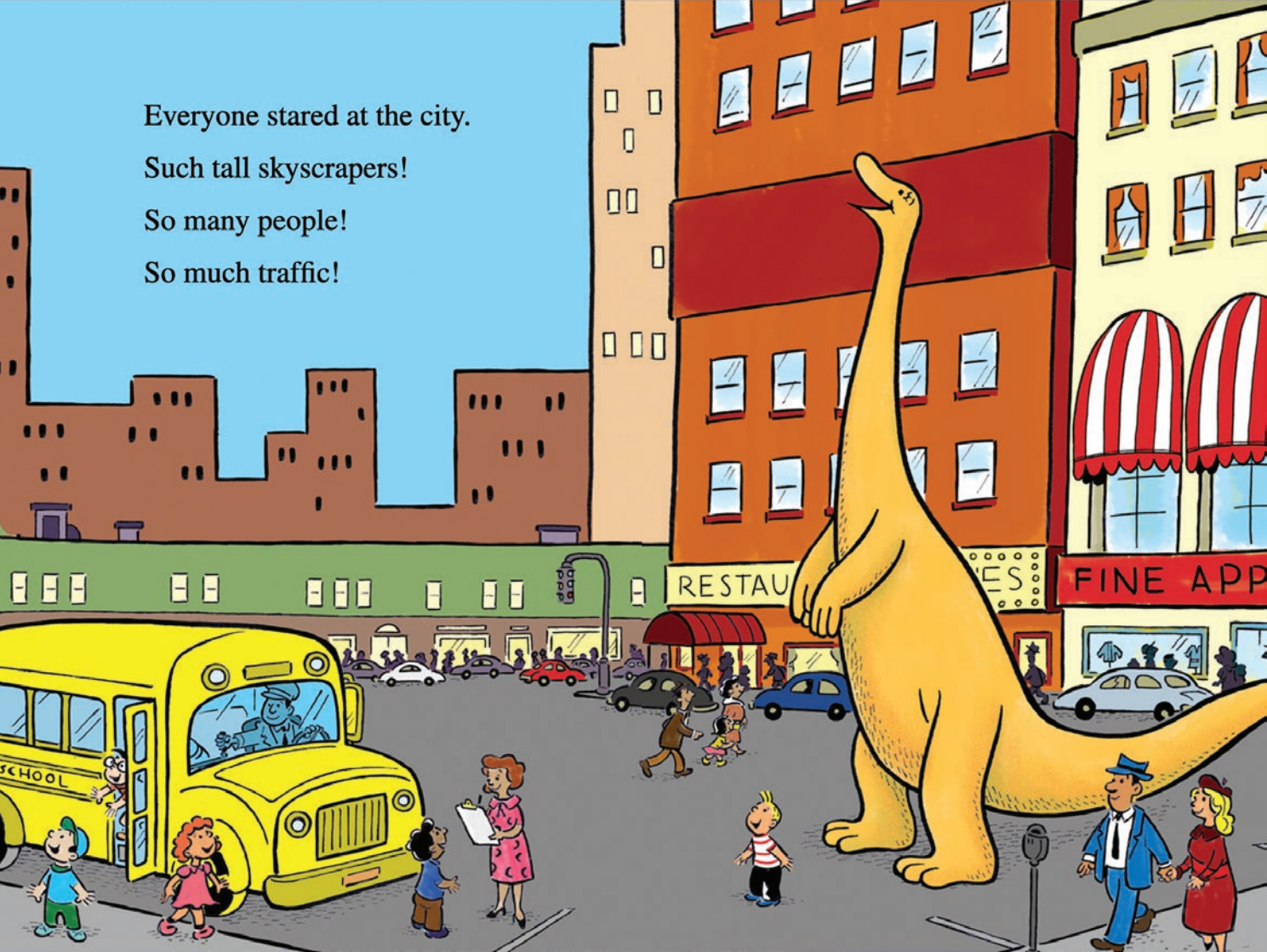
The next day, Danny and his class

but he didn't mind.

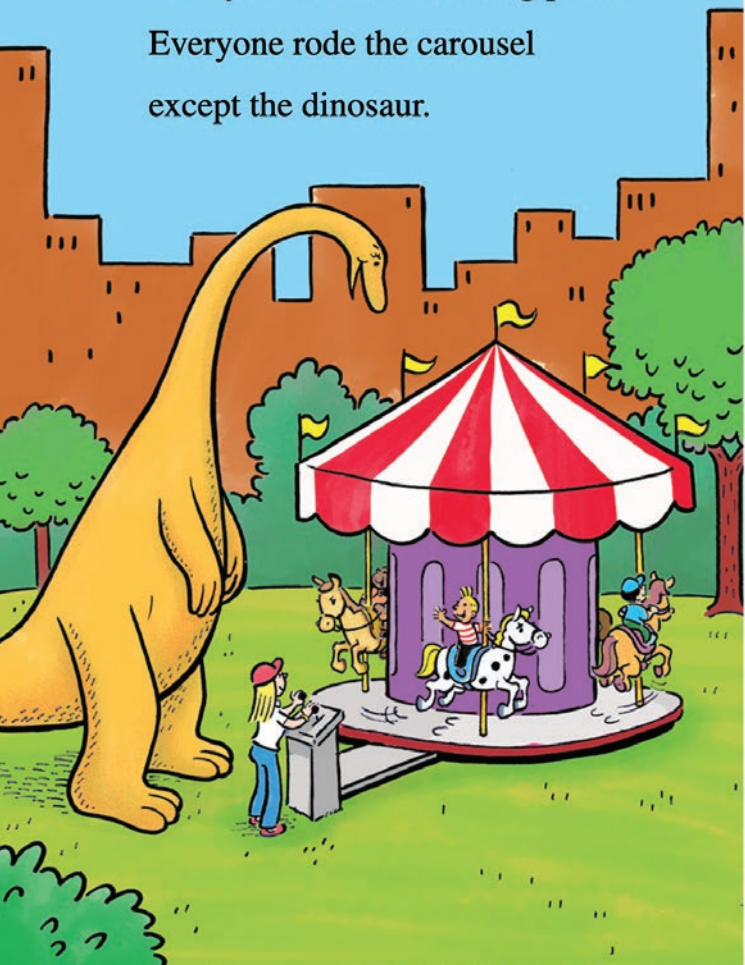


The view was amazing!

a fancy music hall.

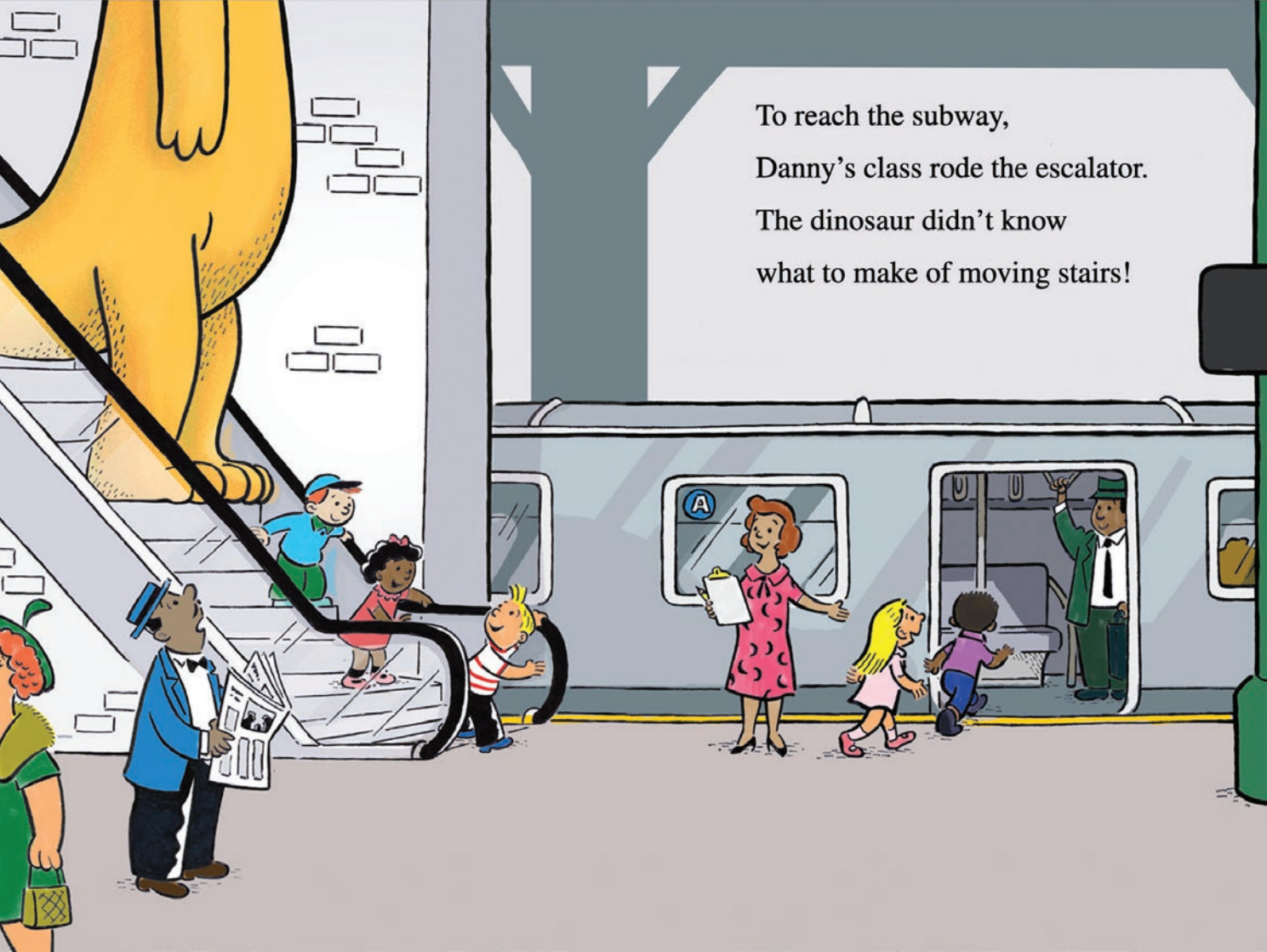
Everybody loved watching

everything shook!



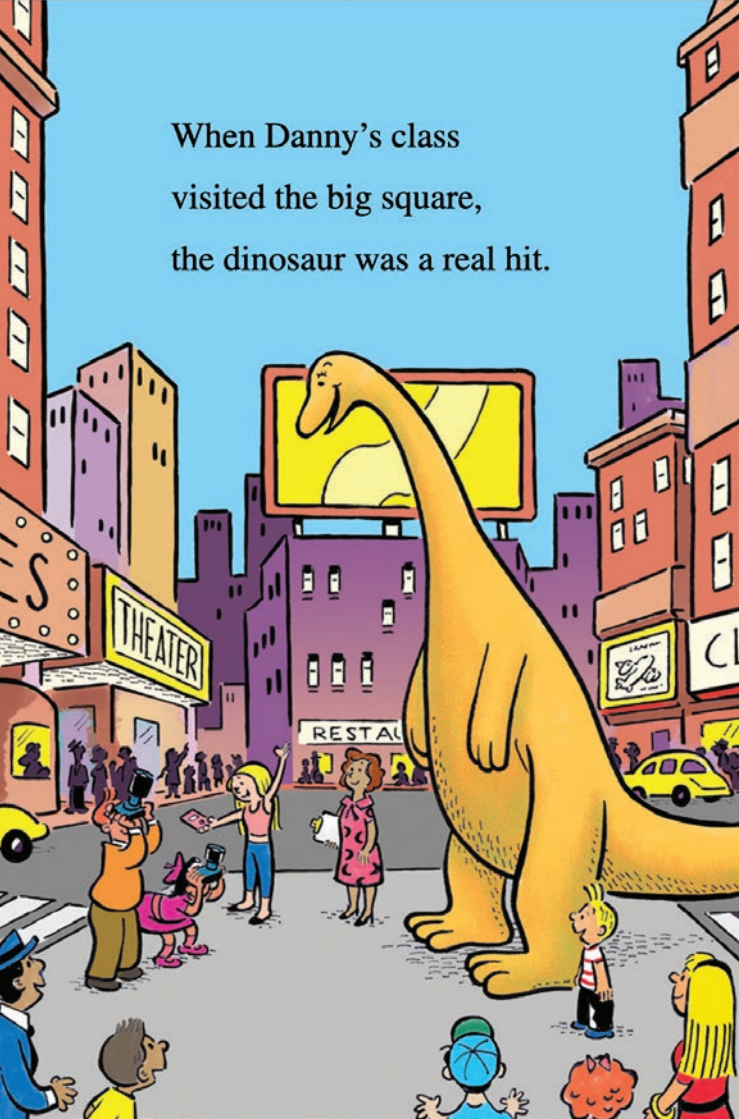
To reach the subway,

to ride underground.

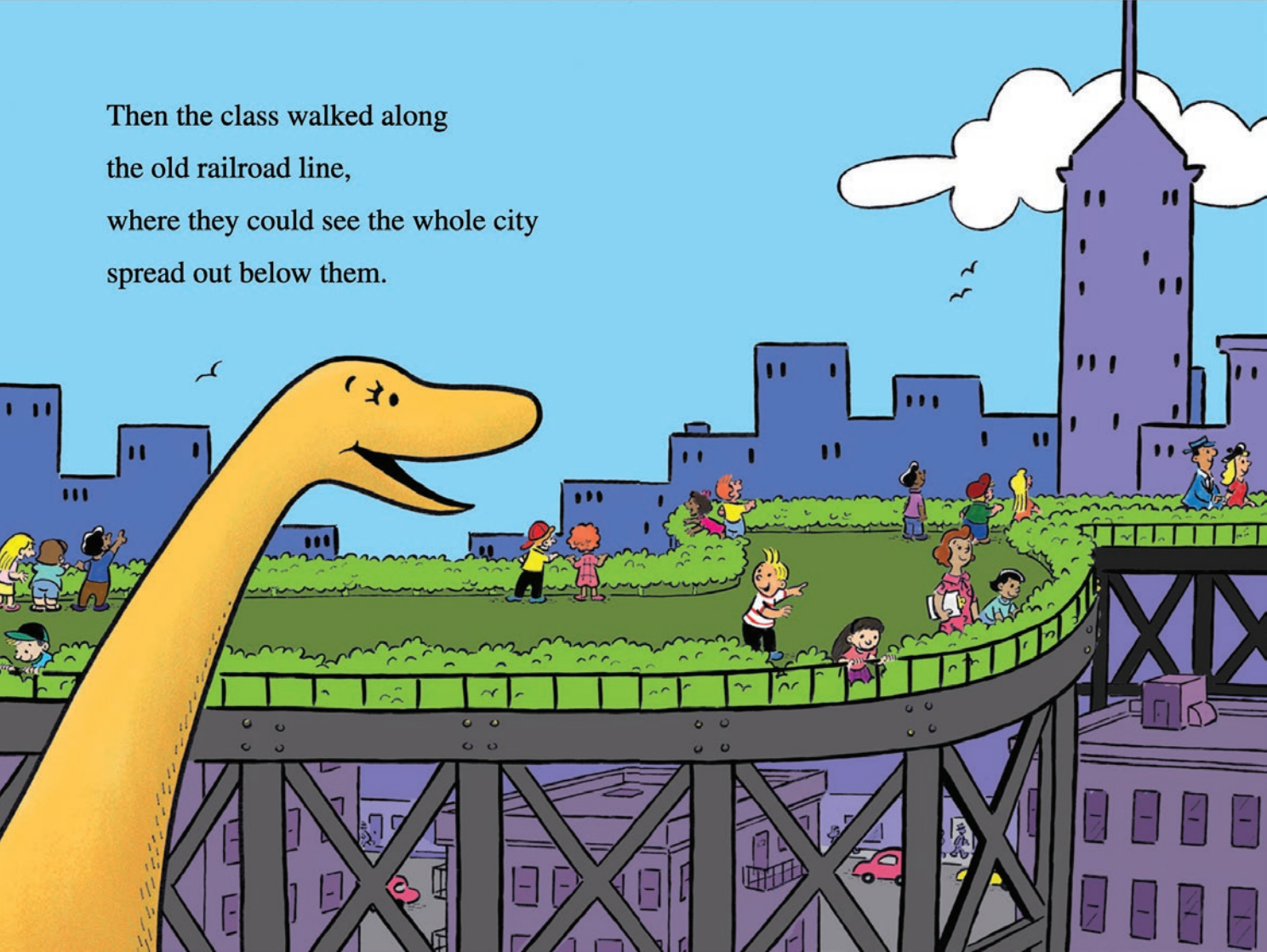


When Danny's class
